This Canadian Sidewheel Steamer was operated by **Lake Ontario & Bay of Quinte Steamboat Company** across Lake Ontario from 1868 - 1892, running between Rochester and Port Hope and down the north shore to Toronto.

It was first built as Norseman in 1868 at Montreal for **HH Gildersleeve** of Kingston. Later it was rebuilt in 1891 and renamed **NORTH KING**.

The **NORTH KING** ran between Toronto and Rochester and later between Kingston, Oswego and Rochester for Richelieu & Ontario Navigation until the R & O became part of Canada Steamship Line.

NORSEMAN is believed to be shown here in the Port of Charlotte in Genesee River.
