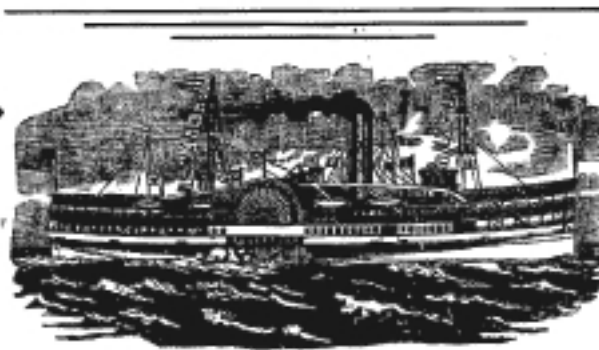

GENESEE RIVER AND LAKE ONTARIO STEAMBOAT COMPANY

Owned and operated by **Captain Jacob DeLaBarre Scott** in Rochester New York from 1895 onward, JD Scott gained the name "Excursion King" for his numerous touring ventures. He would sell tickets for a round-trip day excursion from downtown Rochester, travelling on the **Rochester Electric Railway** to the lower falls of Genesee River. Travellers sailed to the lake by paddlewheel steamer to the Port of Rochester (Port of Charlotte) out into Lake Ontario to Ironquoit Bay at Sea Breeze. The trip would return to downtown Rochester via the **Rochester and Lake Ontario Railroad** (the "Bay Railroad"). His offering included starlight trips, which were the popular adventure of the time. JD Scott's company owned a number of vessels, including City of Rochester, JD Scott, Titania, Algona, Charlotte, Eleanor, Damascus, Brewer, and Sea Breeze 1 & 2.
